From all of us here at the Ventura County Library, we'd like to extend our heartfelt sympathies to those who have been impacted by the wildfires. We were also devastated to learn that the Los Angeles Public Library's Palisades Branch Library was destroyed in the recent Palisades Fire. During emergencies like the fires, libraries continue to step up and help their communities with access to supplies and information. With the Palisades Fire, people gathered at the Los Angeles County Topanga Library where supplies were distributed and people could charge their phones. And with the recent planned power outages in Ventura County, our Ventura County Libraries served as places where people could come and charge devices and access the internet. During the Thomas Fire, our libraries played the same roles as well as distributing face masks and other supplies to residents. And our libraries often serve as places where people can access air conditioning or heat during weather emergencies, and they don't have to purchase anything to stay and do so.

It is important to recognize libraries as vital community hubs and institutions in times of disaster, and to allocate resources adequately to fully leverage the potential libraries have to do even more for the communities we serve.
