RULES FOR THE SUPERVISION OF MINORS

THE LIBRARY IS A PUBLIC PLACE, AND WE ASK OUR VISITORS TO RESPECT OTHERS BY ABIDING BY THE FOLLOWING RULES FOR THE SUPERVISION OF MINORS:

- Parents, caregivers and teachers are responsible for the behavior of children under their supervision.
- Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible caregiver 13 years old or older.
- A responsible adult must directly accompany preschool children at all times.
- Library staff cannot assume responsibility for children at any time.
- If an unattended child is in the library at closing time, police will be notified and asked to pick up the child.
- Library staff is not permitted to offer the child transportation home.
